

LAKE COUNTY RESIDENTS

If you have never received a Tdap vaccination as a child/adolescent or are due for your Td booster (every ten years as an adult) and are either on Medicaid or are uninsured, you are eligible to receive the Tdap vaccine at no cost. This differs from your usual “tetanus shot” (which also protects against diphtheria) in that there is the pertussis component. Pertussis, also known as “whooping cough”, and the Center for Disease Control and Prevention recommends that adults receive this vaccine.

The Lake County Public Health Department has secured this vaccine from the Minnesota Department of Health and is available to residents of Lake County who are either uninsured or have a Medicaid product.

Tdap vaccinations are available for eligible residents on **Friday, April 13 from 12:30-4:00pm** at the **Bay Area Medical Clinic, Silver Bay, MN** and on **Monday, April 16 from 9:00am-11:30am and 1:00-3:30pm** at the **Lake County Health and Human Services Building in Two Harbors, MN.**

Both clinics are walk-in only.
