

## Download this [Location Marker](#) app to your mobile device

1. Search for [USNGapp.org](#) a browser or Apple app store.
2. Save it as a bookmark or favorite.
3. Turn on “Location Services” on your phone.

(Android: Settings/Connections/Location)

(iPhones: Settings/Privacy/Location services)

4. **Ready! Your location will change as you move.**

The app is browser based, so it works on any mobile device, even when you have no cell service. Simply click to open it before you leave your service area, and the coordinates will continue to work by satellite while you travel.

US National Grid (USNG) coordinates are easy to use anywhere by anyone, and are the US and Minnesota standard for search and rescue response. If your map includes a USNG kilometer grid on the sides, you can use them to tell your friends where you are anytime (read east first, then north)
