	Probability (45%)	Severity (30%)	Warning Time (15%)	Duration (10%)
4	Likely every year	Federal declaration and support. Catastrophic impacts with fatalities, evacuation, loss of utilities, communication & infrastructure for many weeks.	Up to 6 hours	More than 1 week
3	Likely every 3 years	State resources are needed to respond. Utilities out for up to 1 month. Up to 50% of infrastructure is damaged.	6-12 hours	Less than 1 week
2	Likely every 5 years	Local mutual aid responds near to capacity for up to 1 week. Some structure damage and utilities out.	12-24 hours	Up to 1 day
1	Likely every 10 years	Local response can manage the impacts within 3 days. Most utilities intact.	Over 24 hours	Up to 6 hours
