Wildfire is one of the greatest hazards threatening our residents and property in Lake County. To prevent or reduce the impacts of wildfire, we've partnered with other agencies to promote Firewise Communities, offer Firewise evaluations of homes and defensible space, install dry hydrants for remote water sources, provide funding to install external sprinklers and metal roofs, sponsor roadside chipping program and community debris drop-off sites, and remove hazardous woody fuels on over 800 acres of private property.
