

## LAKE COUNTY MENTAL HEALTH TASK FORCE

### May 2018 Minutes

1. Meeting called to order. Pastor Dean then moved to approve agenda; Kim seconded. Motion carried.
2. Judie motioned to approve minutes; Dolly seconded. Motion approved.
3. Consumer Concerns-Pastor stated Shannon J had been invited to attend meeting, but had not arrived. Kim shared that the Waterfront Center clean up day had been postponed due to bad weather, and that a trip to Tom's Logging Camp was on the May schedule. Pastor Dean then brought up plan to recess July/August versus Karen's proposal to do so during the winter. Items discussed included the impact this would have on a community forum event, and if this was still an option. Lisa H shared information on the Region 3's promotion of "Let's Talk , as a possible "starting point"; Pastor Dean referred to Northland Healthy Minds. Pastor then moved to further examine his proposal to have speakers attend the monthly meetings and present information on various mental health topics, and use local advertising to promote interest and attendance at task force meetings, and to make final decision in June. Dolly seconded; motion carried. Pastor Dean then moved that we research the "Let's Talk" crisis number; Kim seconded. Motion carried. Lisa H will bring informational materials to the next meeting.
4. Old/New Business-Items addressed included task force application submitted by Rob Laska, consumer. Also, questions as to whether Elaine J is still interested in membership, as she has not attended several meetings. Karen's lack of attendance was also questioned, due to current meeting location. It was decided to reach out to them before determining potential resignations.
5. Pastor Dean motioned to adjourn; Dolly seconded. Motion carried.
