

LAKE COUNTY ORDINANCE # 1
AN AMENDMENT TO THE
LAKE COUNTY HEALTH ORDINANCE

Add the following new section to the "Design and Construction Requirements for Individual Sewage Disposal Systems."

Section 9. HOUSEHOLD GRAY WATER SYSTEMS.

For purposes of this section "graywater" is defined as those liquid wastes generated as a result of ordinary household culinary activities and includes bathing wastes.

Where other than water carried excreta disposal systems are used, graywater disposal may be accomplished by the following method.

Graywater shall be piped to a sewage tank with no less than 1/2 inch pipe and not more than 2 inch pipe.

The sewage tank shall be of watertight construction with a minimum capacity of 300 gallons. The smallest dimension of the sewage tank shall be three (3) feet and shall be baffled in the same manner as a septic tank. A liquid depth greater than five (5) feet shall not be considered in determining tank capacity. The plumbing system shall be properly vented in accordance with acceptable plumbing standards. Garbage grinders shall not be connected to the graywater systems.

The effluent from the sewage tank shall be treated in a soil absorption bed equal to 50 per cent of the area requirements shown in Table II, Section 4, of the Design and Construction Requirements section of this ordinance. The graywater system shall be subject to final inspection by an authorized Health Department inspector before any part of it is covered.
