WHEREAS, the Lake County Board of Health at their meeting of June 12, 1979, approved and forwarded recommended amendments to the ordinance to the Lake County Board of Commissioners, and

WHEREAS, the Lake County Board of Commissioners hereby approves and ratifies the Board of Health recommendations as outlined in the legal Notice of Intent by the County Board to adopt same which was published in the August 29, 1979, issue of the Lake County News Chronicle.

RESOLVED, That the Lake County Ordinance Number Seven (7) is hereby amended in accordance with the published legal notice,

RESOLVED FURTHER, That the Lake County Board of Health make appropriate changes, additions and/or deletions to the compliance standards of said ordinance to reflect the requirements of the amended ordinance.

Limited Food-Service License	10.00
Intermittent Food-Service License	10.00
Temporary Food-Service License	10.00

hereby rescinded.



AMENDMENTS & CHANGES

In accordance with the findings and recommendations of the Lake County Board of Health, the Lake County Board of Commissioners conducted a public hearing at their regularly scheduled Board meeting of September 5, 1979 in the Commissioners Chambers, Court House, Two Harbors, Minn. and officially adopted the following amendments and changes to the Lake County Food Service Ordinance also identified as Lake County Ordinance Number 7. The amendments and changes shall become effective immediately.

Amend Section 1 - Definitions, by adding a definition of: "Boarding House" to be inserted in between the definition of "approved" and "food".

BOARDING HOUSE - The term "Boarding House" shall mean every building or structure or enclosure, or any part thereof used as, maintained as, or advertised as, or held out to be an enclosure where meals or lunches are furnished to five or more regular boarders, whether with or without sleeping accommodations, for periods of one week or more.

Amend Section 1 - Definitions, by adding the words *Boarding House* to the definition of "Food-Service Establishment" after the term "mobile restaurant", and before the words "coffee shop".

Amend Section 1 - Definitions, by adding the following definitions immediately following the definition for "FOOD-SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT".

INTERMITTENT FOOD-SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT shall mean any food service establishment which operates at a fixed location intermittently at a frequency not to exceed one day per week during the month or months covered by the license.

LIMITED FOOD-SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT shall mean an itinerant establishment or one serving only pre-packaged foods which receive no more than heat treatment.

Amend Section 1 - Definitions, by changing the definition of "TEMPORARY FOOD-SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT" as follows

TEMPORARY FOOD-SERVICE ESTABLISHMENT shall mean any food-service establishment which operates at a fixed location for a temporary period of time, not to exceed an aggregate of *fourteen (14) days* in any one license period in connection with a fair, carnival, circus, public exhibition, sale or similar gathering.

Amend Section 6 - Enforcement Provisions as indicated:

Subdivision 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a food-service establishment within the jurisdiction of the Lake County Board of Health who does not possess a valid license or permit issued to him by the Health Officer as required by this regulation. Only a person who complies with the requirements of this regulation and the standards of the Lake County Board of Health shall be entitled to receive and retain such a license or permit. Licenses and permits shall not be transferrable from one person to another persons or place, provided *except* that the license for any portable or mobile food-service establishment may be transferrable from place to place at the discretion of the Health Officer. A valid license or permit shall be posted in every food-service establishment. Licenses for temporary, *intermittent*, and *limited* food-service establishments shall be issued for a period of time not to exceed *the limits established for that classification*. The license year shall be January 1 to December 31 next succeeding.

Amend Section 6 - Enforcement Provisions as indicated:

Subdivision 10 - For the conventional and temporary licensing, surveillance and inspection services required by this ordinance, fees shall be charged for the following: Food-Service Establishment License, Temporary Food-Service Establishment License, Intermittent Food-Service Establishment License, Limited Food-Service Establishment License.
