Area III meeting June 14th

Hourly, non-exempt employees are expected to work their regular hourly schedule and may not "flex" hours from one work week to the next. With approval of the District Manager, an hourly employee may flex hours within their work week (e.g. work four 10 hour days instead of five 8 hour days). Employees who are exempt and paid on a salary basis are expected to work as many hours as are required to complete their work and meet the deadlines and expectations of their position. More flexibility may be granted to the exempt employees under state and federal law.
