POSITION: COOK

The current vacancy is for one part-time position in the Lake County Sheriff's Office.

SALARY: \$17.37 - \$23.45 per hour

CLOSING DATE: Open until filled; initial review November 7, 2023

Applications must be on official forms. Resumes will be accepted, but not in lieu of an application.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

High School Diploma or G.E.D. and 1 year cooking or related experience; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Responsible for preparing and cooking meals. Responsibilities may include monitoring food inventory; washing utensils; and sanitizing kitchen areas.

WORK TEST PERIOD:

Appointee to the position must successfully complete probationary period per contract.

BACKGROUND CHECK:

Applicants selected for appointment must pass a background investigation.

DRUG TESTING:

Applicants selected for appointment must take and pass a drug test.

PHYSICAL-MEDICAL STANDARDS:

Applicants must meet essential physical requirements of the position.

EMPLOYMENT ELIGIBILITY VERIFICATION:

All new employees must complete and sign employment eligibility verification form on the first day of employment. Documentation verifying identity and employment eligibility must be submitted within three days of the first day of employment.
